Enforcement Procedures in Areas with New Sanitary Sewer

- 1. Summit County Public Health (SCPH) will receive a list of properties which have not connected to the new sanitary sewer lines.
- 2. A Notice of Violation (NOV) will be sent to the owner of the property. The NOV will include deadlines for connecting the home to sanitary sewer and abandoning the septic system.
- 3. If the deadlines listed in the NOV are not met, a second NOV and Environmental Health Orders will be issued to the homeowner. The orders will include a new deadline to complete the sewer connection and septic system abandonment.
- 4. If the deadlines issued in the orders are not met, enforcement actions will continue with an administrative conference and ending eventually in legal action.
- 5. An extension may be requested by the homeowner at any point during the process. The extension application will be included in both notices.
- 6. Information regarding funding assistance will be included in both notices.
- 7. Enforcement will be concluded at any point once the property is connected to sewer and the septic system is abandoned.
